

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

WHEN AND WHERE:

The Race is on Saturday September 20th, 2008 in Brandon. Registration begins at Princess Park at 8:30 AM and the race officially begins at 10:00 AM. Teams must be back to Princess Park to the finish point by the cut-off time at 3:00 PM.

WHAT YOU'LL GET:

Each team will receive the following items at the beginning of the race:

1. 'The Amazing Science Race' water bottles
2. ID tags (to be worn as the outer layer at all times from start until the finish line)
3. Bus Transit routes map
4. Activity Stations map
5. Clue Sheet
6. A memorable experience that will challenge you mentally, physically, and emotionally through crazy Amazing Science Race activities!

WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING:

- **Paper and Pen:** in case you need to write something down along the way.
- **Cell Phone:** This could come in handy for so many reasons ... bring one if you can!
- **Digital Camera or Camera Phone:** Will be used for one of the challenges.
- **Appropriate Clothing:** Race will be on, rain or shine!!
- **Bottled Water:** There are no water stations on the course because there is no set course.
- **Energy Bars:** In case you get hungry on the course.

HOW TO PREPARE FOR RACE:

- Get a good night's sleep the night before the race
- Eat a good breakfast on Saturday morning.
- Give yourself plenty of time to get to the event on Saturday morning.
- Bring the recommended items with you to race.
- Be open minded and have a sense of humour
- Dress appropriately for the weather that day

FINISH & POST-RACE:

- The Amazing Science Race officially ends 5 hours after the start (3:00 pm). All teams are required to return to finish by that time to enjoy some awards, cold beverages, and camaraderie with fellow participants. Teams that have not returned to the finish within the time limit will be considered unranked.
