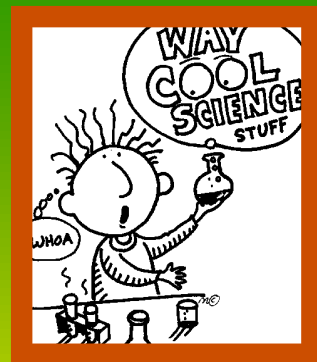


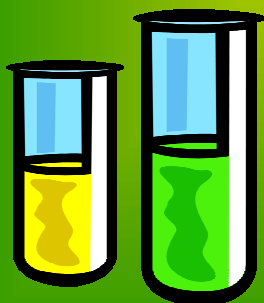

Having a school science fair will give your students the opportunity to develop an interest in the field of science, while improving their knowledge and skills. The students with the top projects of your school science fair can be entered into The Western Manitoba Science Fair held on April 9, 2019, where they will compete with students from all over Southwestern Manitoba for numerous awards and cash prizes. In addition, the students with the winning projects at the Western Manitoba Science Fair will receive an all expenses paid trip to the Canada Wide Science Fair which will be held in Fredericton, NB May 11 - 17, 2019. This week long event gives participants the opportunity to compete for close to \$1,000,000 in cash prizes, scholarships, and special awards!

After your school fair is over, your top winners (gold and silver medal winners) can enter the Western Manitoba Science Fair. Please confirm the quality of the project(s), and only send your TOP PROJECTS (see the Participant's Guide on our website under the Entries section for more details and guidelines). The following steps will help you register students for the Western Manitoba Science Fair. All forms, as well as additional information, can be found at www.wmsf.com.

- ♦ Each individual student, group or class project must complete a separate entry form. Each form must include the self-nominated awards list. The list of self-nominated awards will be updated on our website. Students may self-nominate their project for up to five of the available awards.
- ♦ Please make sure all grade 7 - 12 students have a proper Project Report attached to their entry form. Please see the 2018 WMSF Participant's Guide for report guidelines. It is also recommended but not mandatory for Grades 6 and under.
- ♦ Carefully adhere to the official safety rules and regulations found in the 2018 WMSF Participant's Guide on our website at www.wmsf.com. All finalists should read through this guide completely.
- ♦ The judging booklet and judging forms are on the website. Please have your finalists look at these forms carefully, as it will help them understand what the judges are looking for.
- ♦ When you have completed all the Entry Forms, fill in the **Registration Summary**, staple a cheque to the top of the form, and send the package to the **Entries Chairperson at 637 10th Street, Brandon, MB, R7A 4G6 by Friday, March 23, 2018. A confirmation will be sent out by email shortly after the deadline for entries. Please be sure you have provided an email address for this confirmation.**

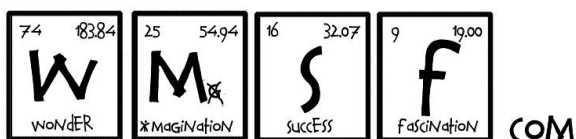
